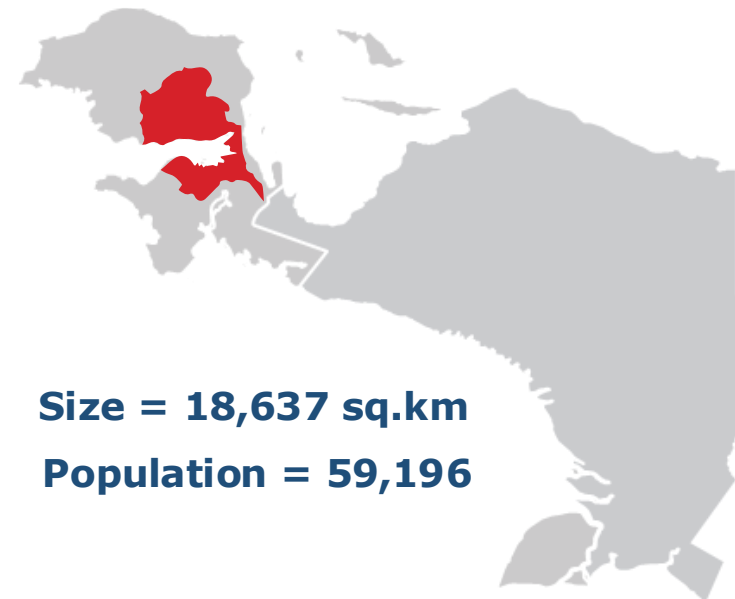

Case Study 1 – Papua Barat, Indonesia



Size = 18,637 sq.km

Population = 59,196

Region

Bintuni, Papua Barat

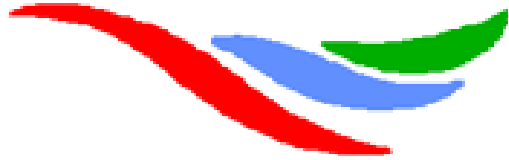


- Economically underdeveloped region but with 800Bn Barrels of Oil and Gas Reserves
- 2nd highest Unemployment Rate in Indonesia
- Low workforce engagement with local projects



Challenge

TANGGUH LNG



- BP Tangguh LNG Project 2009 - ?
- 10,000 workers, 50% currently local population
- Govt set target in 2017 for 85% of workforce to be local population by 2029 – sustainability



Solution



- Indonesian Government provided land and grants for Petrotekno to create 3 x bespoke training facilities in Bintuni
- Petrotekno developed ECITB approved course training and testing standards for International Health and Safety Passport (IHSP), Scaffolding, Rigging, Pipefitting, Welding and Electrical & Mechanical Maintenance etc.

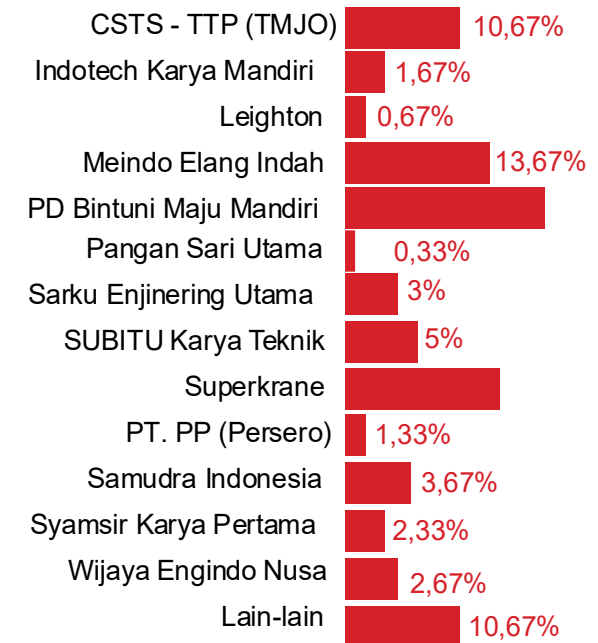


Result

- 2 x 3-6 month residential courses each year
- 100 x 16-21 year old locals per course
- Now on 30th course
- 3000+ graduated - 99% into local employment

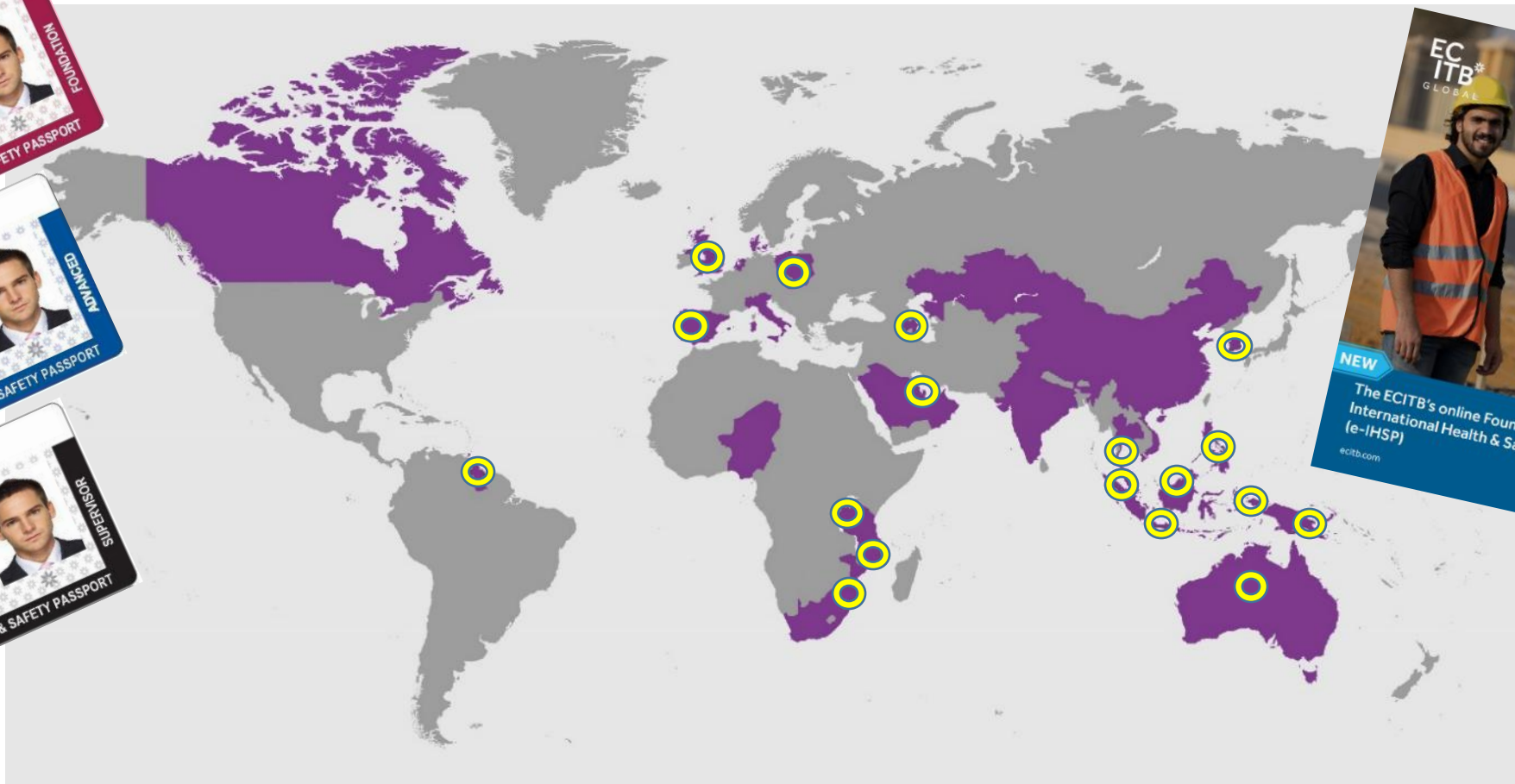

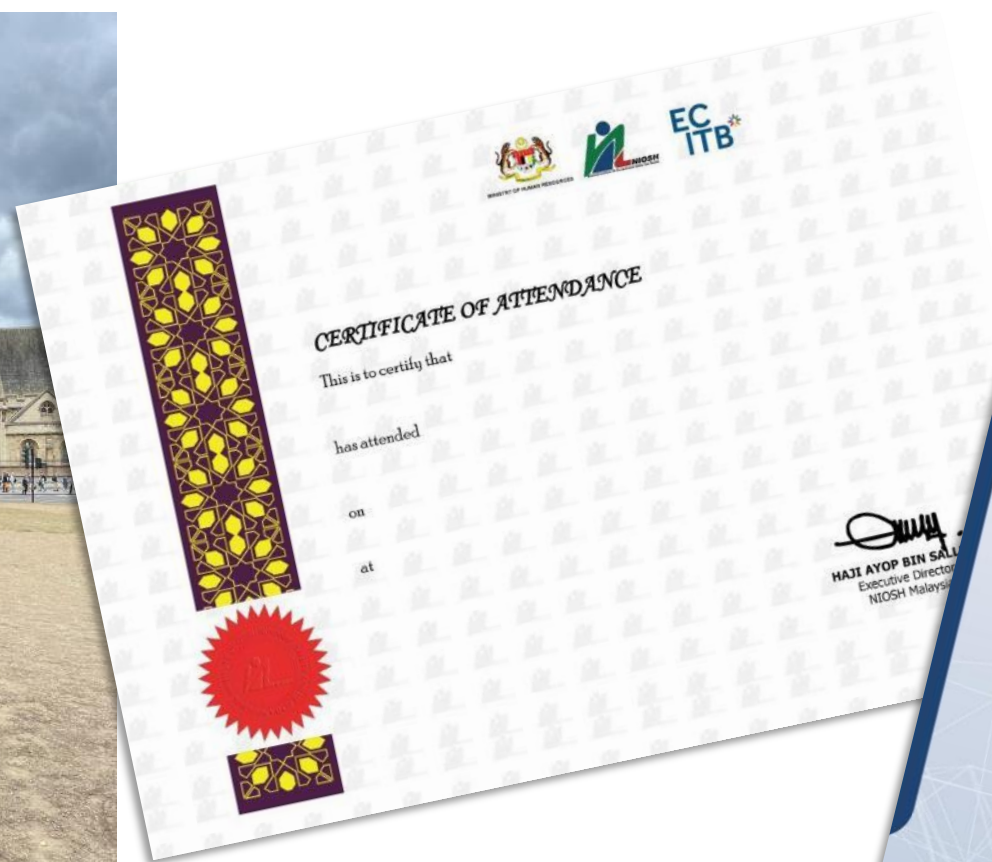
