

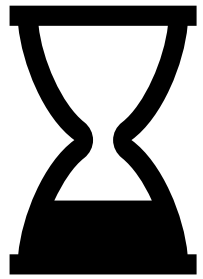

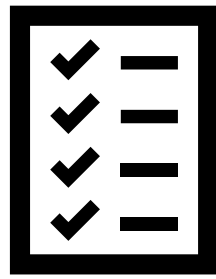

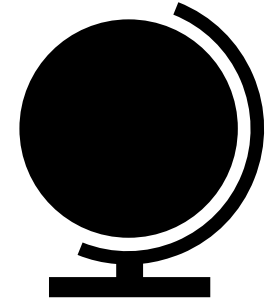

Microcredentials

- **What are they?**

Small, focused modules of learning that verify specific skills or knowledge.

- **What are their key features?**

They're flexible and stackable; rapid to design and deliver, can be mapped to national or international frameworks; provide verifiable proof of attainment

- **Why is this important?**

They can address rapidly changing labour market needs; offer bite-sized recognition of lifelong learning; support skills mobility and employability

A passport to work

- **The Hospitality Skills Passport is a nationally recognised digital credential**
- **It is endorsed by the trade body for hospitality in the UK and accredited by OCN London**
- **It is suitable for delivery through various (work-related) programme formats, including:**
 - Apprenticeships
 - Employer-training programmes
 - Skills bootcamps
- **It confirms learners have demonstrated:**
 - Practical capabilities in areas such as food safety, customer service, teamwork, and hygiene
 - Core knowledge about hospitality operations
 - Workplace behaviours, such as professionalism, collaboration, and problem-solving
